

#### BATTERY SORTING GUIDELINES

All batteries must be sorted by chemistry or type. Each container must be labeled with Universal Waste label. All terminals must be taped before being placed into the container.

## IDENTIFY CHEMISTY / BATTERY TYPE

- Alkaline
- Lead Acid (Pb)
- Nickel Metal Hydride (Ni-MH)
- Nickle-Cadmium (Ni-Cd)
- Lithium Ion (Li-ion)
- Lithium Primary

If battery does not fall under one of the above categories, please keep separate.

## TERMINAL PROTECTION REQUIRED?

Alkaline 1.5V or less = NO Greatever than 1.5V = YES

**All Lead Acid Batteries = YES** 

All Nickel Metal Hydride Batteries = YES

**All Nickel-Cadmium Batteries = YES** 

**All Lithium Ion Batteries = YES** 

**All Lithium Batteries = YES** 

#### **NOTICE:**

Battery terminals that touch metal surfaces or other batteries can spark, causing fire or explosion.
